School Budget - \$3,253,944 for 2025/2026 school year

- 75% covers teachers/staffing
- 21.1 teachers = \$2,417,729
- 7 support staff = 381,650
- 2 (4) admin - includes learning leaders \$332,195

- Student enrollment - 449 with a capacity 476 but planning on closer to 500 next year which means opening up more spaces for classes and hiring more teachers as needed
- Technically opened 2 brand new classrooms this year with increased enrollment and were given a grant for 2 classrooms worth of furniture and smart boards

2025/2026 school fees - broken down by Field trips, artist in residence, outdoor school for grade 6's, swimming lessons for the entire school and recorders for grade 4's

2024/2025 School Fees - Revenue vs expenses - school was short \$2174.65 which is parents not paying their students fees for any of the programs - The parent Council donated \$14,280.46 and has in previous years helped out by paying outstanding fees.

School improvements - painting to be done of the school hallway walls and doors, and 3 classrooms getting a refresh.

- Learning commons reno completed with a new paint job over the summer and new furniture, smart board and removal of outdated power supplies
