Mr. Steinke - Bridges Program (4.5 yrs) - Serves kids with complex and severe mental health challenges as well as dysregulated behavious - consists of one teacher and on BSW - Ms Sasha. The support includes a system strategists, psychologist, and a family lesion - most students are integrated into grade programs and the teacher goes into multiple classrooms through the day. There are 10 students maximum in the program but the teacher and BSW are there to support any child and teacher as needed. They follow a SEL (Social Emotional Learning) checklist to track progress throughout the year. WE ARE TEACHERS OF ALL STUDENTS = success of the program!
